Our local food bank is associated with Connecticut Food Share and is able to purchase food at a reduced price. Unfortunately, recent cuts to funding from the Department of Agriculture in the Local Good Purchase Assistance program will affect the availability of food to purchase.

In the meantime, the food bank clientele has increased over the years.

n March 2025 we served 52 families (109 individuals).

In March 2024 we served 27 families (72 individuals).

In March 2023 we served 17 families (28 individuals).

The Food Bank is in great need of help from all of us, If you are able to help fill the shelves and feed our neighbors, it would be greatly appreciated.


